Much discussion centered around such issues as whether a dollar amount should be established which could be spent by the District without Group ratification; what is considered "property"; whether the District should establish a AISL (Alanon Information Service Liaison) position; the violation of Tradition 4 with the formation of the second Saturday night meeting in Venice.

Everyone was cautioned to encourage Alanon participation by double winners and to make them feel nothing but welcomed when they attended an Alanon meeting.

The subject of how to handle disruptive Alanon members was discussed with the following suggestions offered as possible solutions: (1) The groups do not need to accept unacceptable behavior and a member can be asked to leave; (2) Take the disruptive member outside for a one-on-one; and (3) Take a group conscience.

_____ reported that Alanon is on the Inter-Net and meetings are held from 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., seven (7) days a week.

Alanon World Service has ruled that double winners can be sponsors of an Ala-Teen Group.

New Group Representatives will be elected at the August meeting; District elections will be held at the September meeting. Groups should have their out-going Group Representative and their in-coming Representative attend this meeting. The Area elections will be held at the October 18, 1996, Assembly (Holiday Inn, Punta Gorda) at which both the out-going and in-coming Group Representatives should attend. At the District level, the following positions will be up for election: District Representative, Alternate District Representative, Secretary, Treasurer, Where and When Editor, CPC/PI, Alateen, Archives, Literature, Group Records Coordinator and Newsletter Editor.

All groups were asked to bring to the September District Meeting the names, addresses and telephone number of their NEW group representatives (G.R., Alternate G.R., Secretary and Treasurer) not only for the Permanent Mailing List but also for World Service.


